AL GHAZI'S PENNY stalked the pace, assumed command on the turn, swung wide entering the stretch, inched clear and drew off past the eighth pole under mild urging. DE SICA saved ground, angled out on the turn, bid five wide, couldn't gain on the winner but prevailed for place. FIRE TALKER trailed the field, bid inside on the turn and was outfinished for second. DR. RIZZ set the pace to the turn, fell back and faltered past the eighth pole. BIT OF SUNSHINE lagged early, went seven wide at the top of the lane and failed to rally. IRISH SNOWFALL broke slowly, raced mid pack, had no stretch response and dropped back.
