Footnotes

BLACK DAPHNE held off the pace for a half mile, closed up mid way around the turn, angled six wide to the top of the lane, gained steadily under strong left handed urging, and was up late for the win in mid track. SCARLETLIN loomed inside rated forwardly for three quarters of a mile, angled out leaving the turn, rallied to split rivals at the sixteenth marker, and came second in deep stretch. MIZ SKYWALKER stalked the pace for a half mile, advanced to press around the final turn, bid to the front at the quarter pole, took the lead to the lane, held position at the eighth pole, but was outfinished in the final stage running. SOUNDS OF COURAGE set the pace for six furlongs, but weakened in the drive. MISS CASSIDY raced wide through the far turn, and was no factor going to the wire. MS. CINDY reared at the start and never reached contention. CONTINENTAL QUEEN pressed the pace for a half mile, but faded steadily thereon.
