WINNING VISION reached the front entering the turn, showed the way to the lane and drew off while being ridden out. HIT THE BOTTLE chased and three wide into the stretch, finished steadily and was clear for the place. R LAST HOORAH vied early, saved ground on the turn and chased then weakened in the drive. BONITA ROCK up close early between rivals, dropped back heading into the turn, was four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. CACTUS SHINES vied through the opening stages, was along the inside and dropped back entering the turn, was along the rail through the lane and lacked the needed response. JODY'S HOME saved ground into the turn, was off the inside into the stretch and lacked a bid. KOA KANE broke slowly then lacked a rally. TWIN FREDRIC wide to the turn, trailed and raced a bit greenly in the lane.
