FREE CORONA was never far off the pace, rallied entering the far turn to challenge for the lead, dueled past the eighth pole and drew clear. CEETOIT sprinted clear to set the pace, responded when challenged on the turn to duel past the eighth pole and yielded to finish second best. SINGIN N D SHOWER raced mid pack, went four wide leaving the turn, bid and hung. WESHUDAKNOWNBETTER saved ground, bid on the second turn and came up empty. THATSUSINTHEOLBEAN went five wide in the drive and failed to rally. MANILASTERRE was not a factor. SUNDAY MEMORY raced in the back, lacked a bid and was outrun.
