NADIRA well placed early from the outside, reached the front nearing the furlong marker and drew clear a sixteenth out then held off VEE VOOM (NZ) nearing the wire. VEE VOOM (NZ) lodged a bid outside nearing the top of the lane and finished gamely. MAGICAL MONDAY was steadied along the inside entering the clubhouse turn and rounding the initial bend, settled close up inside, eased out some for the drive and gained some late. WALK WEST prompted the early issue, moved to a narrow advantage on the final turn and weakened in the drive. FOOL'S DETENTE raced in the three path into the lane and lacked a solid stretch response. NORTH OF RIO set the early pace, saved ground and tired through the lane. RED MIMI raced outside turning for home and lacked a response.
