LOVELY TAK saved ground, advanced along the rail on the turn, angled out near the sixteenth pole for racing room, surged and got up at the wire. SHOT FOR GRANDMA broke in, stalked the pace, challenged three across on the turn, dueled through the stretch, had the lead late and was caught at the wire. HARMONIOUS UNION stumbled at the start to be off slowly, went four wide leaving the turn and found her best stride late. RIO BRILLA bobbed a bit at the start, vied past the sixteenth pole and yielded grudgingly. FINE FELINE was a bit crowded at the start, went wide in the drive and drifted out. CANONITA stumbled at the start, vied inside past the eighth pole and faltered. SLEEZEE MISS bobbed a bit at the start, veered in near the gap, had the rider steady, raced close to the pace inside, eased out on the turn and faded through the stretch.
