CAPT. JOE BLOW vied for the lead and dueled to deep stretch then slowly edged away in the final strides. FRONTENA CAT vied for the lead with the winner and dueled to deep stretch then gave ground grudgingly late. DERBY CAT saved ground on the turn then shifted out four wide at the top of the stretch and lacked a bid. ROCKIN ZOLA raced between foes to the turn, took the three path into the stretch and lacked a solid bid. KING JUSTIN was also between foes into the turn, and three wide into the stretch then lacked a solid bid. AWESOME GRAF trailed and stayed inside to the stretch and lacked a bid. OLYMPIC MOMENT broke awkwardly and was left behind his field, then couldn't seriously threaten. R. BEAU was a factor to the stretch, was four wide into the stretch and weakened.
