RENEGADE CIELO took the two path on the turn, took hold and split foes in the late stages and was up in the last jumps. SHOXY vied for the lead while four deep into the stretch, took a short lead late between calls then just failed to last. MIKE'S TRIPPIN vied for the lead from between foes throughout, responded in the drive then gave ground grudgingly late. PALMETTO ROAD was well placed into the turn behind the battling leaders, stayed inside and lodged his bid along the rail at mid stretch then hung in the crucial stages. GOOD BAD BOY vied for the lead from along the rail to deep stretch then weakened slightly in the closing strides. STEALINTHEJACKPOT stumbled at the break then was bumped recovering and was not a factor. GOTTA GETCHA vied for the lead from between foes to midway on the turn then tired. ZYPHYR COVE was hung five deep on the pace into the turn, was seven wide into the stretch and tired. CLURIOSITY was asked down the backstretch, failed to respond and trailed throughout.
