MR CHARLYPOTATOES three wide early and well placed, challenged for the lead on the final turn, reached the front in the stretch and edged clear then held HIDDEN POINT safe nearing the wire. HIDDEN POINT a bit reluctant loading, broke a bit slowly, lodged a bid on the final turn and finished willingly while not quite good enough. RED LINE lodged a bid on the second turn and was gaining late outside. SHIMMERING DUNES well placed early, saved ground into the far turn, lost position on the final turn then gained some in the drive between foes. AUSTINTAYSHAUN set the early pace, responded when asked on the final turn then weakened in the drive. GRANDPA ROY pressed the early issue and weakened on the final turn. SNOWBOUND WARRIOR outside down the backstretch, drifted wide into the lane and tired.
