MUSICLEDO saved ground turning for home, eased out in the lane and finished well while drawing out late. CATCH MY TALE outside into the turn, chased and challenged for the lead a sixteenth out then was second best. WOBBLY FELLOW trailed and moved out for the drive then closed well late. ROJO RED set the pace and weakened in the drive. PIRATE JACK well placed early and near the rail on the turn, tired in the drive. VALID VALENTINO saved ground and lacked a rally. FIRST OPPORTUNITY raced just off the rail turning for home and lacked the needed bid. GOTTA DANCE JO JO raced five wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. CALL SIGN ICEMAN loaded without the rider, chased early between rivals, weakened into the lane then was not urged late.
