IRON FORTITUDE saved ground, rallied into the turn, assumed command along the rail, drew clear and held under mild urging. TOMMY AND BUSTER bore out entering the first turn, set the pace, bore out on the second turn, fell back, continued willingly once straightened but didn't have enough late. JOE BLACK SANDY was carried out entering the first turn, pressed the pace, was carried out on the second turn, tired, dropped back but held for show. MATAMOR lagged off the rail, offered a mild bid inside and improved position. STORMY SEATTLE trailed the field and passed tiring rivals. OH SO MACHO was carried out into the first turn, fell back, raced wide thereafter and did not threaten. JUST HEAT was restrained leaving the gate, was never far off the pace, advanced around the far turn but had nothing left for the drive.
