FATHER JONES was never far back while racing outside, rallied five wide on the turn, went seven wide into the stretch, closed under steady left handed urging and got up in the final strides. STEAMY STORY stalked the pace, challenged for the lead on the turn, dueled past the eighth pole, inched away and was caught near the wire. AWESOME IN BLACK raced close to the pace, angled out for the drive, bid five wide, went willingly to the wire but didn't have enough late. FOX IN THE HOUSE was fractious in the gate, raced in the back, bid eight wide and finished well. LAKE SAWYER saved ground, bid off the rail to loom a threat but didn't have enough left. BIG CITY BERNIE was rated back to trail, went nine wide at the top of the lane and offered a mild bid only. MATUCO (ARG) was sent to the front to set the pace, responded when challenged on the turn, dueled past the eighth pole and faltered. WE GOT DA FEVA raced close to the pace inside, got through along the rail on the turn, had nothing left and faded from contention. GHOST RIDE showed speed to the turn and gave way.
