BOLD N BAD raced five wide into the lane, drifted in some passing the eighth pole then drew clear. PARTY WITH GARY well placed while saving ground, eased off the rail late and earned the place. TARTUGA ISLAND eased out some for the drive and was gaining late. STARRY STRIVE tracked early, moved to a narrow advantage on the final turn, showed the way into midstretch and weakened to the wire. STORM WITH CLASS drew well clear on the clubhouse turn, saved ground and weakened in the drive. ROB THE MOMENT raced just off the inside while forwardly placed and lacked the needed stretch response. JO LANNY broke a bit awkwardly, lodged a bid on the final turn and raced four wide into the stretch then tired in the drive. CROWN FRANK lacked a rally.
