CLURIOSITY bobbed at the start, challenged for the lead three wide and between rivals passing the quarter pole, reached the front in upper stretch and drew clear. DOGGIE BEAR raced wide and advanced heading into the far turn, continued wide into the lane then finished willingly. SWISS SONATA stumbled at the start, lodged a four wide bid nearing the quarter pole and loomed a threat then weakened in the drive. CAN'T FIND ME vied for the lead, raced along the inside into the lane and tired in the drive. DR. POOH raced four wide turning for home and lacked a stretch bid. SOFT DEFENSE prompted the issue down the backstretch, reached the front between calls on the final turn and weakened into the lane. FRANK ROYAL (ARG) showed little. LUVS A COURTING vied early, saved ground and gave way rounding the final turn.
