LITTLE TRAVIS was asked for run on the turn, reached the front passing the eighth pole and drew clear. SILVER DAYBREAK up close early and near the rail, raced in the three path into the lane then came back on and earned the place. IMIRONHIDE trailed and six wide into the stretch, finished gamely. STAR PACKER set the pace inside and weakened in the drive. THE COLONELS CAT broke a bit slowly, saved ground on the turn and raced between rivals late then gained some. BUBB BYE saved ground and lacked the needed late response. ROLL ON GOOD BUDDY four wide into the turn, chased from the outside and tired in the drive. FRONT SIGHT chased early, raced three wide on the turn and tired.
