THAT TIGER set a pressured pace to the turn, drew off for a clear lead and held safely while being kept to task. PARTISAN GOLD raced close to the pace, rallied four wide leaving the turn, couldn't threaten the winner and was all out for place. STRATEGIST broke awkwardly to be off a bit slowly, went seven wide entering the stretch, closed fast and was gaining late. SURE THING EVA bobbled at the start, lagged early, went six wide leaving the turn and narrowed the gap. AGGRESSION stalked the pace, hung in the lane and lost position. DISMISS THE LOT failed to threaten in an even effort. PEACE SIGN was never far off the pace, advanced inside on the turn and came up empty. RAD CAT was outrun. MARK THE TRAIL pressed the pace inside to the turn and gave way.
