ONERY DOLLARS pressed the pace to the second turn, assumed command, drew clear in the upper stretch and extended his lead under urging. ISLAND DRUMS broke in and bumped at the start, lagged, eased out for the drive, bid but was no match for the winner. SCRIMMAGE bumped and was squeezed at the start, bid five wide and got up for show. GOOD GUY set the pace to the second turn, responded when challenged, tired, faded and was caught for third. DASHER DAWN was never far off the pace, bid willingly but came up empty. SUNSET KID was slow early, went seven wide in the drive and offered a mild bid only. KEYSTOTHESTORM improved position in an even effort. GENKI raced close to the pace, advanced to the far turn to loom a threat and gave way. SCOOTER S. bumped and was squeezed at the start and was not a factor. ONE OF THE GUYS stalked the pace, was through after a half and steadily faded from contention. STRIKER BEAN bumped at the start, had the rider steady on the first turn, saved ground and was through after a half.
