LONDYN PEYTON lodged a three wide bid on the turn, dueled for command through the lane and edged clear late. HARLEY HART vied for the lead, raced along the inside through the stretch run and could not match the top one late while second best. BEHRENS AFFAIR raced off the inside on the turn and lacked the needed stretch bid. SEASIDE FRIENDS broke a bit slowly and steadied early, raced five wide turning for home and lacked a stretch bid. NIKOSEERA stumbled to be away awkwardly, raced outside on the turn and offered little in the drive. JOANNIE ZAJAC veered in early, saved ground and tired through the lane. CHECHILIA MIA broke awkwardly, moved up early and drew clear on the backstretch, saved ground then tired through the lane. QUEEN JOYCE bobbled at the start, saved ground on the turn and lacked a bid.
