PALACE MISTRESS rallied four wide on the second turn, drew off near the eighth pole, was kept to task and won going away. LISIANSKI was hustled along for position, settled off the pace, assumed command into the turn, vied to mid stretch but was no match for the winner. RUMBLE CREEK raced close to the pace, rallied into the turn to loom a threat, hung but held for show. AMBER GOT EVEN raced mid pack in a steady effort but couldn't gain ground. WINTER IN SEATTLE lunged at the start, advanced inside around the turn, leveled off and faded. SCARLETT'S PLACE improved position in an even effort. MAGGIE'S DRAWERS was not a factor. SO DIVINE saved ground, bid along the rail on the turn to loom a threat, tired and dropped back. UNLOCH THE FURY was not a factor. PATPEGBERN was not a factor. GALLANT VICTORY set the pace, was through after a half and stopped.
