ONE CALL set the pace with a clear lead and held safely under mild urging. ILIKECHOCOLATEMILK angled in at the top of the stretch, closed well inside and finished second best. BULLITTONE saved ground, eased out for the drive, bid five wide and got up for show. HIDDEN BOUNTY chased the pace, bid, hung and was caught for third. WHO'S RALPH raced mid pack, bid six wide but didn't have enough left. CLAY W. WOODSTOCK was never far of the pace, rallied into the turn to loom a threat, tired and faded from contention. DE SICA was not a factor.
