### Footnotes

MAGNIFICENT VAL got away well, set the pace, was under pressure through the stretch and held well in a driving finish. ASPEN HILL held a good position inside, bid between horses on the turn, closed willingly and was outfinished in a good effort. FRISCO BELLE was void of early speed while saving ground, advanced along the rail, eased out in the upper stretch and finished gamely. COLOR ME FAST was slow early, went five wide leaving the turn, bid and hung. SHE'S FINDING TIME stalked the pace to the second turn and flattened out. NORTHGLEN was never far off the pace and gave way on the second turn.
