### Footnotes

HECTOR raced three across, dueled throughout and prevailed in a long drive. CERTAINLY CERTAIN dueled throughout in a rail trip and was outnodded to just miss. CACTUS BREEZE saved ground mid pack, got through along the rail on the turn, bid gamely and outfinished. COOKIE'S FROM TONY was never far off the pace, rallied four wide on the second turn to challenge and went willingly to the wire. BABY FACE ASSASSIN was unhurried early while never far back, went five wide in the drive and lacked the needed late rally. CASE SETTLED dueled between horses to the second turn and gave way.
