HOOKED ON GOLD vied to the upper stretch, inched away for a short lead and drew off late in a driving finish. COSTAPLENTE pressed the pace between horses, was taken back from tight quarters entering the turn, came again four wide and earned place while no threat to the winner. ANNAPOLIS FLYER was never far back, went five wide into the stretch, offered a mild bid only and got up for show. MR. BARMAN broke out and bumped at the start, vied along the rail to the upper stretch, fell back and gave way. WHAT'D I TELL YA stalked to the turn, fell back and had no further response. DESERT LIGHTNING bumped and was squeezed at the start, saved ground and lacked a bid. SHERIFF BUCK broke out, went six wide entering the stretch and showed little. ROYALTY IN EXCESS was reluctant to load, broke awkwardly and was pushed out at the start, had a wide trip and was not urged late.
