NO REVERSE lodged a bid on the final turn, raced four wide into the stretch and finished gamely to prevail. WOLFGANG prompted the early issue, was asked on the final turn and raced three wide into the lane, raced between foes late and finished gamely. COLD PRINCE drew clear soon after the start and moved inside, was rated on the pace, raced just off the rail entering the stretch then yielded late. THE SHAUGHRAUN was checked off heels along the inside on the clubhouse turn then rank briefly, pulled on the backstretch, raced just off the inside turning for home, was angled back in in upper stretch, altered course outside for a clear path passing the sixteenth pole then finished willingly. BIG MAX broke a bit awkwardly to be away a bit slowly, raced five wide and lacked the needed rally. DR. POOH away a bit slowly, raced four wide and lacked a stretch bid. CASA MIA up close and three wide into the far turn, chased and weakened through the lane.
