Footnotes

CUVEES CHOICE broke sharply, set a pressured pace and drew off past the sixteenth pole under mild urging. TAPADERO bid between horses into the turn, closed steadily and got up for place while no threat to the winner. SEEKING ROSES pressed the pace, challenged for the lead on the turn, faltered past the sixteenth pole but held safely for show. SCARY MIDNIGHT raced close to the pace, failed to rally and was not a threat. FIRMLY ORIENTED broke slowly, trailed the field and offered a mild bid only. MEGAMIGO showed good early speed inside, was steadied into the turn and faded from contention. MATUCO (ARG) hit the gate at the start, was never far off the pace, had nothing left for the drive and gave way.
