KINGSBURG trailed early and near the inside turning for home, eased out for the drive and finished gamely to prevail. SNOWBOUND HALO came out some at the start and vied for the early lead, challenged again in the stretch and finished gamely. BENJAMIN BABY saved ground on the turn, raced between rivals inside the furlong marker and loomed a solid threat but was not good enough. TIE ROD raced between foes on the turn and lacked the needed late response. CANYON POINT vied for the early lead, drew clear on the turn and weakened in the drive. CAPT. JOE BLOW chased early inside, moved out on the turn and tired in the drive. TWOWAY HARD TEN bumped at the start, chased early and weakened on the turn.
