UPPIE LOU was five wide while moving into contention on the turn, continued five wide into the stretch and lodged her bid and was along in time. O K GOLDEN JET dueled for the lead throughout, responded when challenged in the stretch and held on well to the finish. MOTHER'S SAUCE saved ground while just off the leaders on the turn, lodged her bid along the rail in upper stretch but wasn't good enough. DEAL 'M HIGH moved inside into the turn, stayed on the rail for the drive and lacked a bid. TIME TO FIND broke slowly, angled six wide into the stretch and never seriously threatened. SEA AVALANCHE vied for the lead from outside and stayed in contention to mid-stretch then tired the final furlong. WAVE PLENTY was never in contention. MISAWA was never far back in the run to the turn, lodged a three-wide bid midway on the turn then tired in the stretch.
