SMARTY MATT was always in contention, lodged his bid a furlong out, came in some and bumped a rival then edged clear late. PATRIATE set the pace, responded in the stretch, came out some and was bumped late then was second best. R E O SPEEDDRAGON was never far back, came five wide into the stretch then lacked a solid late bid. SUNSHINE ALPINE was bumped at the break, came seven wide into the stretch and lacked a bid. ROYAL BULL moved inside on the turn, took the two path into the stretch then lacked a solid late bid. COYOTE MOON was close up early just off the leaders, took the two path into the stretch then lacked a bid. HEZA PLAYBOY settled some early, took the three path into the stretch but didn't seriously threaten. SHADOW JUSTICE rated after the start, fell back some into the stretch then lacked a further response. IRISH VOLUNTEER moved up while three deep into the turn, stayed in contention into the stretch then tired. OBSTRUCTION saved ground to no avail. SPLASH HIT had brief speed in the run to the turn, was five wide into the stretch and tired.
