GRANDPA ROY pressed the pace to the second turn, assumed command and drew off under mild urging. DYNAMIC RANGE raced close to the pace, rallied around the turn, bid four wide, couldn't gain on the winner and was all out for second. BRITISH COLUMBIA was unhurried early, saved ground to the second turn, bid eight wide and was gaining for place. STORMY SEATTLE raced mid pack inside, failed to rally and did not threaten. VICTORY CHECK lagged, went six wide at the top of the stretch and lacked a bid. JUST JEBICAH was away well to set the pace to the second turn, stumbled, tired and dropped back.
