SHIMMERING HEAT away alertly, duelled for the early lead outside a rival, drew clear nearing the eighth pole and widened leaving the furlong grounds then held BLUMIN BEAUTY safe nearing the wire. BLUMIN BEAUTY four wide into the turn, raced six wide into the stretch and finished gamely. MIRANDO broke a bit awkwardly to be away slowly, raced in the three path entering the lane then got the show award outside rivals. SPICE THIEF raced four wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response then was vanned off. BOY TOY chased early from the two path, raced three wide into the lane and lacked the needed response. LITTLE PURSUIT saved ground and lacked the needed response. ESTACADA bumped a rival at the start, saved ground turning for home and lacked a stretch bid. WINNING WEAVE bumped leaving the gate, was outrun. SWEET KENDALL JO duelled for the lead into the stretch from along the inside and weakened in the drive. WILD ENGLISH ROSE was outrun.
