THREE POINT PLAY raced close to the pace outside, rallied into the turn, went five wide at the top of the lane, bid willingly and drew off past the eighth pole in a driving finish. RUSTIN RHETT raced mid pack, bid six wide at the top of the lane and got up for place while no threat to the winner. YOU MAKE ME BLUE saved ground, offered a mild bid only and was outnodded for second. SOUL OF A SAMURAI broke out, set the pace past the eighth pole, faltered, shied from the whip and ducked out near the wire. MUSICAL DEPUTY broke in, raced close to the pace, fell back on the turn, offered a mild bid inside, had little left and was crowded near the wire. KELA DAWN chased the pace, had nothing left for the drive and faded through the stretch. STRETCH SLEW broke slowly, raced wide around the first turn, fought being rated, fell far back and trailed under mild urging. DYNAWAKI broke slowly, bore out on the first turn, fell far back and was not urged thereafter.
