EDGERIN J was unhurried early, advanced through traffic around the turn, eased out for the drive, closed willingly to get up late and drew clear. KINGSVILLE saved ground while close to the pace, eased out on the turn, challenged three across, dueled to deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. ROGUE RIVER advanced inside, bid along the rail, dueled for the lead, weakened late but held safely for show. MANSIONES pressed the pace, fell back on the turn, continued willingly but didn't have enough left. TAPADERO set the pace, responded when challenged on the turn, dueled to mid stretch and faltered. CAVANAL pressed the pace to the second turn and flattened out. GLENWICK broke out and failed to menace in an even effort. FATHER JONES pressed the pace to the second turn, tired and gave way.
