**Footnotes**

SUN CITY vied early then wrangled back inside, took over three wide passing the quarter pole and drew clear then was not seriously threatened. ROLLIN STOCK raced three wide and between rivals turning for home and finished willingly while second best. KRISTEN'S LIL LADY trailed early, raced four wide into the lane and offered a mild stretch gain. BUDS N ROSES saved ground to the lane, moved around a rival passing the sixteenth pole and needed more. OURPRETTYSALLEYJO lodged a bid outside on the final turn, was in the four path into the lane and lacked a stretch response. PARIS WEEKEND saved ground to the lane and lacked a rally. OUR COCO BEANS saved ground and vied for the lead then weakened in the drive. DOUBLE ZADO between foes into the clubhouse turn, vied for command and tired through the lane. BROOKIEOFTHEYEAR pressed early three wide and gave way. SLY KITTY four wide early, chased and weakened on the final turn.
