**Footnotes**

TONIGHT AT ELEVEN moved up down the backstretch to a challenging position, lodged his bid at the top of the stretch, dueled the length of the stretch and took the head-bobbing decision on the wire. OCONEE was clear into the backstretch to set the pace, responded to a challenge on the far turn, dueled the winner the length of the stretch and just failed to last. SIBERIAN PUNCH saved ground into the backstretch, eased out to the four path for the stretch then finished willingly late. ILIKECHOCOLATEMILK settled some after the start, was taken five wide into the stretch then lacked a solid late bid. HOLLYWOOD ADVISOR raced three wide into the far turn, was four wide into the stretch then lacked a solid late bid. MAKINYOURMARK forced the early pace on the first turn then chased the leader down the backstretch and weakened the final furlong. BOLD ESSENCE saved ground around the first turn then fell back and was never a factor.
