Footnotes

NOBLETY vied for the lead to midstretch, took a short lead then drew off late under right-handed urging. HEADED FOR HOME was three deep while not far back into the turn, stayed in the three path into the stretch and finished well. PATRIATE was four deep on the pace into the turn, stayed four wide into the stretch then lacked a late bid. CHANGING LANES vied for the lead with the winner to mid stretch then weakened the final furlong. CONDITIONAL flashed early speed then saved ground on the turn, stayed on the rail for the stretch and lacked a bid. WESTERN COMMENT was five wide much of the trip and lacked a rally. PURR FOR ME was five deep in the middle of the pack down the backstretch, came six wide for the drive and lacked a stretch bid. COURTING SEATTLE was between foes on the turn, was five wide into the stretch and didn't seriously threaten. BLUE CARACAL saved ground to no avail. MATUCO (ARG) forced the early pace and was three wide nearing the quarter pole then tired in the stretch.
