WARREN'S BLVD. showed good early speed, fell back, was checked entering the turn, awaited room, bid along the rail, was in tight quarters, dueled for the lead and inched clear late to prove best. JANZIG AFFAIR pressed the pace between horses, challenged for the lead on the turn, dueled to late stretch and yielded to finish second best. FIGHTING WONDER broke sharply, pressed the pace outside, went four wide on the turn, dueled to late stretch and hung. FUTURE SEARCH moved up outside to set the pace, responded when challenged to duel and faltered near the sixteenth pole. IMAGINI was in tight entering the turn, swung wide leaving the turn, went eight wide in the drive and narrowed the gap. WEST FORTY lagged, swung wide leaving the turn and failed to rally. AL GHAZI'S PENNY was not a threat. BARTOKS BRAVEHEART broke slowly and was outrun.
