FAR TOO GRAND well placed early, drifted out some into the lane then responded gamely to prevail between rivals. FRISKY VIXEN saved ground while setting the pace, responded gamely and just failed to stay. MADAME BLACKFOOT stumbled at the start, moved five wide for the drive and finished gamely. BERNIES IRISH GIRL eased out for the drive and closed well late. BRIGHTON BOOK well placed early and in the three path into lane, raced in traffic and finished willingly. DANCE N DENAE saved ground turning for home, raced along the rail through the lane, was behind foes briefly then was not good enough. MOVIN EAST saved ground and loomed a threat into midstretch and weakened. MANZERITA raced six wide into the lane and lacked the needed response. PRESENTEE tracked early, lodged a bid on the final turn and weakened in the drive. INSTANTLY RIGHT broke out some and steadied at the start, lacked a rally. N' WE DANCE raced a bit wide into the clubhouse turn and was through early.
