PAVIA lodged a bid on the turn, raced four wide into the lane and finished steadily to prevail. WALK WEST moved five wide turning for home and finished gamely. ACE'S HIGH saved ground into the turn, raced in the three path into the lane and challenged for the lead in midstretch and finished willingly. SIMPLY BASIC reached the front three deep on the turn and weakened in the drive. SHESOURSNOW raced six wide turning for home and offered a mild gain. HOLLY ARTS lacked a rally. DONNA'S VAUDEVILLE raced between foes while pressing the issue and tired in the drive. SLEW THE MONEY chased early, raced outside on the turn and weakened. COME ON CRYSTAL saved ground and vied for the early lead then tired in the drive .
