CHARISMATIC MIST moved up along the rail to the turn, stayed inside to upper stretch, lodged her bid and wore down leader late. AUNT DIXIE slow to load, set the pace to deep stretch and held on gamely to the finish. ICEMAN MISS trailed early, saved ground to the drive, eased out in upper stretch and finished willingly. BALLYTYNE a bit rank early, forced the pace to the stretch then weakened in the drive. NAPILI raced six wide on the turn, remained well out in the track for the drive and lacked a rally. PRAIRIE EAGLE in contention early, was four wide and lacked any bid. NOT A BULL Fractious, unseated rider behind gate, was shuffled back after the start, raced wide on the turn and lacked a rally. COURAGIOUS SAM raced four deep in contention to the turn, dropped back and tired in the drive. GOJAZ vied for the lead three deep to the turn, dropped back and tired in the drive.
