ROCKY BAR broke awkwardly, set the pace with a clear lead, responded when challenged to duel past the eighth pole and yielded. RAH RAH PARTY raced in the back, closed steadily and got up at the wire for place. SUNNYS BUDDY put in an even effort and failed to menace. TWICE THE ENERGY stalked the pace while racing inside and had nothing left for the drive. LADY'S LIL' RINGER raced in close between horses and gave way leaving the turn. TOP SECRET AFFAIR was not a threat. APPLETON (MEX) showed brief speed and faded from contention.
