CUT OF MUSIC was blocked behind rivals entering the lane, moved out some nearing the eighth pole for a clear path then finished well to prevail. NO TORO always a factor, reached the front passing the furlong marker and continued on willingly. INSTANTLY finished well from the outside. MARBURY never far back, raced wide into the stretch and was gaining some late. ICY TOBIN saved ground turning for home and lacked a solid response. ADROITLY SUPERB vied for the lead into midstretch and weakened. REAL CREEK saved ground and vied for command into upper stretch and tired. SUPERMAN CAN prompted the early issue outside, remained a factor to the lane and weakened. TOO MANY TRAINS well placed early, raced outside turning for home and tired. TOP HIT lacked a rally with the rider losing his whip on the final turn.
