RULE BY FORCE was slow early, rallied six wide on the turn, closed willingly and got up late. BONBONI bumped at the start, assumed command three across on the turn, drew off for a clear lead, led to deep stretch and was outclosed to finish second best. TRIP THE GENERAL was never far back, rallied five wide on the turn, bid, hung but held safely for show. SWISS SKI bobbled at the start, advanced inside, bid and hung. YANKEE BRAVO raced inside to the turn, angled out, bid and came up empty. PATRIOTIC SOLDIER improved position in an even effort. HEZAMAZING passed tiring rivals. CROWN KING pressed the pace outside, was steadied on the turn and stopped. EL RANCHO bumped at the start, pressed the pace, challenged on the turn and stopped. GATLING GUN set the pace too the turn, bumped, had the rider check and stopped. ZENDON flashed speed, stopped and dropped back steadily.
