CLAY W. WOODSTOCK raced inside, vied throughout and proved best. ACCEPT THE KISS raced between horses to the turn, vied throughout and was outfinished in a game effort. SNARK vied three across to the turn, fell back, continued willingly and held for show. QUICK MEETING lagged early, rallied around the turn to get within striking distance and hung late. DUKE DELUXE was slow early, angled out on the turn, offered a mild bid only and failed to menace. TWO ONE GUN was slow early while racing outside, went six wide leaving the turn, bid and came up empty. MIKE'S TRIPPIN was never far off the pace, went five wide leaving the turn and lacked a bid. BEFORE THE PROM showed good early speed along the rail and dropped back steadily. BUCK'S DANCE was not a factor. LIZ'S PIRATE stalked the pace to the turn and stopped.
