JONAAB stumbled and dropped back after being bumped early, advanced outside turning for home and continued to gain ground through the lane. DOUBLE BUBBLE vied for the lead into midstretch and weakened. GEMINEL stayed outside and lacked a late response. CURLITAM pressed the pace and tired. WHATS REALITY saved ground and weakened. ROSES N CHAMPAGNE had little left for the drive. BOULDER QUEEN was through early. CASTELLI MOTEL was outrun.
