WENDEN moved up between horses to set a pressured pace, drew away leaving the turn for a clear lead and was ridden out. LEAFY GREENS raced mid pack, angled out in the upper stretch and closed to get up for place while no threat to the winner. RIO BRILLA showed good early speed inside, fell back on the turn, continued willingly, couldn't gain ground and was outfinished for second. LYMA BREEZE was never far off the pace, offered a mild bid only and gained position. GLENDIVE raced in the back, offered a mild late rally inside and improved position. SONORAN STORM trailed the field and passed tiring rivals. MAMES' GAME pressed the pace while racing off the rail to the turn, weakened and faded through the stretch. MY MELROSE fell back quickly while breaking alertly and failed to respond. MODERATION MARY rallied around the turn to get within striking distance, swung wide and gave way.
