COME ON MAMA duelled to the turn, drew off for a clear and was ridden out. VALARI stalked the pace, went four wide entering the stretch and couldn't gain on the winner despite steady left handed urging. OUR STORM lagged early while saving ground, rallied around the turn, shifted out in the upper stretch and offered a mild bid to earn show. COUNTESS CAPOTE raced mid pack in an even effort and improved position. CASSIE D duelled to the turn, fell back and faded through the stretch. SOCIAL LADY was void of early speed, went widest in the drive and did not threaten. SONORAN STORM pressed the pace inside, angled out on the turn, bid but had nothing left for the drive. A REAL JEWEL showed brief speed and steadily faded from contention.
