PATRIATE showed the way to the lane, responded well in the drive and held a safe margin to the wire. CONGO KING raced in the two path into the lane and finished gamely. WESTERN TWIST chased three wide and finished willingly while not good enough. DIAMOND DAN was steadied slightly into the turn and moved off the inside, chased and weakened late. GLITTERNMEPORRIDGE saved ground and lacked the needed rally. KING JUSTIN raced four wide into the lane and lacked the needed stretch response. BOLD BENGIE raced five wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. CLASSIC MOVER hesitated at the start and raced far back. The stewards posted the inquiry sign concerning CLASSIC MOVER at the start prior to declaring the original order of finish official. The race was hand timed.
