FORT BOWIE vied early then raced in closest attendance, raced along the inside through the lane and reached the front passing the sixteenth pole then drew out. HEREDERO between foes early, drew well clear on the turn and weakened in the drive while holding the place. GOODNIGHT GIN saved ground and offered a mild stretch response. EASTER HARMONY raced four wide into the lane and lacked the needed late response. CHINO VALLEY lacked a rally. SEN NIGHT chased early inside, was five wide into the stretch and tired. RIB EYE was six wide into the lane and offered little in the drive. CLARKDALE hit the gate to be away awkwardly then failed to menace.
