Footnotes

CARNERA raced close to the pace outside, challenged three across on the turn, dueled through the stretch and prevailed in a long drive. TONIGHT AT ELEVEN stalked the pace, challenged between horses on the turn, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished in a game effort. CANARD rallied around the turn, bid seven wide, closed steadily under steady left handed urging and was gaining late. KEEN BIDDER (GB) was unhurried early, advanced around the turn, angled out for the drive, found his best stride late and was gaining ground. SKIMASCO was hustled along to set the pace, leveled off in the drive and faded from contention. ANGELIC FIDDLER stalked to the second turn, fell back, angled out, bid and hung. NO REVERSE lagged a bit early, bid inside entering the stretch and had nothing left for the drive. BULLARA showed speed along the rail on the first turn, dropped back and had no further response.
