DEVGRU pressed the pace, challenged three across on the turn, swung wide entering the stretch, dueled to the sixteenth pole, inched away with a short lead and held well. GLOBAL STORM stalked outside, rallied four across on the turn, was carried out a bit entering the stretch, closed steadily and narrowed the gap. WHY FRANK vied inside to the sixteenth pole and was unable to sustain his bid. NARANJO pressed the pace inside, fell back on the turn, eased out for the drive, went willingly to the wire but didn't have enough late. ROMO TIME vied to the upper stretch, leveled off and faded from contention. FACT IS IM AWESOME trailed while close, fell back on the turn and faded through the stretch.
